How to enter:

Entry for the 2023 NZIOB Next Gen Awards is an online process via nziob.org.nz/studentawards. Entries open on Monday 3 April 2023 and close on Friday 28 April 2023

Eligibility:

Entry is available to:

- Student Members of the NZIOB. Student membership is free for anyone enrolled in any constructionrelated tertiary programme, or in a recognised carpentry apprenticeship. Nominees who are not already
 Student Members of the NZIOB can join via a two-minute online application; and
- In any year of study, full or part time

How to enter:

• The online entry form can be saved partway through and continued later using a link provided to you via email. Information on what is required is listed below.

Video:

- Create a video where you tell us about your big idea to shake up the building industry. Don't hold back with your ideas – we want to hear them all whether they are ambitious, controversial or outlandish!
- Your video can be in any style you like, but you must appear in it in some way. It should be between one and two minutes long.
- Accepted file types accepted are MOV, MP4, WMV.

Written:

- Along with the video you will need to complete the online entry form where you can tell us a bit more about yourself
- The online form can be saved partway through and continued later using a link provided to you via email
- You will also need to provide the name and contact details for a referee who we can call make sure you check with them so they know they have been put forward.
