Our current membership numbers are **1,556.**

- We have 898 Next Gen members and 658 across our paid membership categories.
- The regional split of members is Northern 899, Central – 300, Southern 357
- Gender split 71% Male, 29% Female
- 23 people are currently on the 3 month free trial.

CONSTRUCTION CAREER PATHWAYS PROJECT – (July 2024 to August 2025)

This is a collaborative initiative, project managed by the Institute in partnership with the Building and Construction Training Fund (BCTF) and the University of Canterbury's Building Innovation Partnership (BIP). Funded through the Science Partnership programme by the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment (MBIE).

This project aims to develop clear and accessible career pathways and opportunities within the construction sector, helping to attract and retain talent in the industry.

Recently three online workshops were held bringing together industry partners, vocational education providers, and BCTF members, resulting in positive feedback and discussions. The project is now entering its research phase, Kathryn Davies from BIP is conducting a literature review and interviews with key industry associations to gain deeper insights into the various roles and career pathways outlined in the Singapore Framework, which serves as a guiding precedent.

Thank you to our **13 fantastic sponsors** who helped to make this year's awards a success.


NEXT GEN AWARDS 2024 – supported by Resene
